

Praying the Lord's Prayer

Out of all the things the disciples could have asked Jesus, they ask him to teach them to pray. Matthew 6:5-15 records a prayer he gives them that we can learn much from.

OUR FATHER WHO IS IN HEAVEN

- Thank Him for being your Father. Cf. Psalm 139:1-18
- Thank Him for adopting you into His family through the blood of Jesus. Cf. Romans 8:15-17)

HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME

Declare these Names of God out Loud:

JEHOVAH-JIREH	God Provides	Genesis 22:14
JEHOVAH-ROPHE	God Heals	Exodus 15:26
JEHOVAH-NISSI	God is my Banner	Exodus 17:15
JEHOVAH-M'KADDESH	God Who Sanctifies	Exodus 31:13
JEHOVAH-SHALOM	God is our Peace	Judges 6:24
JEHOVAH-ROHI	God is my Shepherd	Psalms 23:1
JEHOVAH-TSIDKENU	God is our Righteousness	Jeremiah 23:6
JEHOVAH-SHAMMAH	God is There	Ezekiel 48:3 5

YOUR KINGDOM COME, YOUR WILL BE DONE, ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN

Pray this phrase over:

- Yourself and your family
- Your church
- Your sphere of influence
- The city, nation and nations

GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD

- Pray for provision physically, emotionally, relationally, financially, etc.
- Pray over your day in specific detail.
- Pray to abide in God in every situation.

AND FORGIVE US OUR TRESPASSES AS WE FORGIVE THOSE WHO TRESPASS AGAINST US.

- Ask the Holy Spirit to show you any area of sin. Confess and receive forgiveness.
- Is there anyone you need to forgive from the heart? Anyone you need to make things right with emotionally, relationally, financially, etc.? Cf. Ephesians 4:32

AND LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION BUT DELIVER US FROM EVIL.

Pray and build a wall of protection. Cf. Romans 12:1-2

- A mind that is renewed with God's Word
- Eyes that are clean and clear
- Ears to hear God and listen to others
- Hands to heal and give
- A disciplined heart of trust
- Feet that walk toward holiness in all things

- Declare again His greatness and your submission to Him and His will. Cf. Colossians 1:13-18
